Family Cost Participation Program

The Family Cost Participation Program (FCPP) went into effect January 1, 2005. The program was created by the California State Legislature. This law says that some families will be required to pay part of Respite, Day Care and Camping. No other services are affected.

Only families that meet the following conditions will be affected:

- Child between 0-17 years old (0-17 Effective 10/01/2008)
- Child has a Developmental disability
- Child lives in the parental home
- Child receives services and supports **purchased** by a regional center
- Child is not eligible for Medi-Cal or is not Institutionally Deemed.

DDS has developed a sliding scale for families with Adjusted Gross Income over 400% of Federal Poverty Level (FPL) and based on how many people are living in the home. Families with more than one child served by the regional center, the assessed fee varies.

The cost participation amounts will be assessed upon Intake and Eligibility and reassessed as part of the Individual Program Plan.

Parents are responsible to "self-certify" their income through a copy of their most recent federal income tax returns (1040 tax forms). Inland Regional Center will accept copies of the 1040 tax return, w-2 wage earner statements, payroll stubs or other documents and other proof of other income. It is very important that the required documents be forwarded to the POS department within the ten (10) day time period following your IPP via fax (909) 890-3114 or in a sealed envelope. Parents are responsible for notifying regional centers of any change of income that would affect their assessment rate.

Once the family has completed the income documentation, the regional center has 10 working days to notify parents of their cost participation amount. Failure of parents to provide income documentation will result in families being assessed the maximum cost participation (100%) of services.

The regional center's director may grant an adjustment for parents who incur unavoidable and uninsured catastrophic loss with a direct economic impact on the family or a significant, un-reimbursed, medical cost associated with care for a regional center child with receipts. This adjustment must be re-determined at least annually. Inland Regional Center assesses and reassesses on an annual basis of IPP.

Parents may appeal an error in the amount of the parents' cost participation to the executive director of the regional center within 30 days of notification by the regional center and the parents may further appeal the decision of the regional center director regarding the amount of cost participation to DDS within 15 days of the regional center director's decision.
