## New Residential Service Provider Orientation (NRSPO) Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How often are orientations held?

A: Minimum of two times per year but up to four times per year.

Q: Are there fees to attend NRSPO?

A: Yes. Current fee is \$100.00 for entire orientation and \$50.00 for administrator's only.

Q: Is work history verified?

A: Yes, all work history that pertains to providing support to individuals with developmental disabilities will be verified.

Q: How long is the NRSPO certificate valid?

A: The facility must be opened within two (2) years of successfully completing the orientation; otherwise, the full orientation must be taken again.

Q: How long does the orientation last?

A: NRSPO lasts four days, beginning at 9am every day and concluding by 4pm every day.

Q: What experience do I need to open my own home?

A: Please refer to **NRSPO Qualifications** to review required experience.

Q: What are the current needs?
