REQUEST FOR NEED

TYPE OF PROGRAM: Adult Residential Facility (ARF) **Level 4I**

GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION: Riverside County; San Bernardino County

AVAILABILITY OF START-UP FUNDS: Start-up funds are **not available** to support the development of these homes. Applicants are responsible for all costs associated with licensure and start-up activities.

Residential Facility Specifications/Qualifications: **(items in bold are currently our greatest need)**

- Adults Aged 18-59
- Male or Female (Homes can support one gender or both, **Female Only Homes Encouraged**)
- Have a minimum of one or more Regional Center qualifying diagnosis
- May have Co-occurring Mental Health Diagnosis
- Ambulatory or **Non-Ambulatory**
- May require specialized care for medical conditions and/or Restricted Health Care Conditions
- Individuals will have severe behavioral challenges, including, but not limited to, physical aggression, verbal aggression, property destruction, self-injurious behavior, and elopement.
- Staff must be trained in Crisis Prevention and Intervention to properly handle behavioral challenges
- There must be a qualified professional to provide Behavioral Consulting Services consistent with the level of care provided
- Ongoing supports that include 24-hour care and supervised training for those with severe deficits in self help skills and activities of daily living.

FACILITY REQUIREMENTS: The facility should provide a home-like environment with a maximum vendored capacity of four (4) individuals. Each individual shall have his or her own bedroom and a full-size bed or larger. The home must be in compliance with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services issued Final Rule.

CRITERIA FOR RESIDENTIAL APPLICANTS: Potential licensees/administrators for these homes must have a minimum of twelve (12) months prior experience providing direct supervision and special services to persons with developmental disabilities in a licensed and vendored regional center residential facility; Title 17, Ch. 3, SubCh. 4, Section 56037 (d)(1). IRC's Best Practices/Standard is that applicant's 12 months of experience should be in a Level 4I home.

3. Active Administrator Certificate from Community Care Licensing
4. IRC's New Residential Provider Orientation Certificate (New Vendors Only)
