

# IRC Day Program Options

<b>Adult Day Programs:</b>	5 days/week, work on independent living skills, social skills Goals are set through Person-Centered Planning process IRC funds transportation if necessary
<b>Arts Programs:</b>	Visual and digital arts/media programs Emphasis on employment outcome Develops social and vocational skills
<b>Behavior Programs:</b>	Assist consumers with a wide array of behaviors Implement behavior intervention strategies Also work on social and vocational skills
<b>Community Integrated Programs:</b>	Work on community skills such as transportation, finances, employment Can include Paid Internship Program Can be used with other programs
<b>Work Activity Programs:</b>	Sheltered warehouse environment 5 days/week Sub-min wage/Piece-rate
<b>Group Employment:</b>	Groups of 3 Mostly warehouse, landscape and janitorial positions Can be min. or sub-min. wage
<b>Customized Employment:</b>	Program works with student and circle of support to discover their strengths, interests and passions. The ultimate goal is placing the individual in a job that they will enjoy and be successful in for the long term with natural supports
<b>Supported Employment:</b>	Job coach provides assistance to ensure success Minimum wage positions or Paid Internship Program helps develop employment opportunities
