IRC Non-Residential Vendors and IRC Community Services:

This is a new directive giving added guidance to the March 12th DDS Directive regarding the State of Emergency and funding for nonresidential service provision due to COVID 19 absences.

- 1. All service provision will be subject to review or audit, so vendors must be documenting and keeping that documentation from the initial change from face to face to remote/teleservice.
- 2. Beginning in May, DDS expects that all nonresidential service providers, "first seek and apply for all available COVID-19 relief funding before receiving absence funds through regional centers."
