Case Management Trainee (Part-Time and Full-Time)

Starting Rate: \$21.50 per hour

This position is a 6–12-month training position that is responsible for the direct case management of services offered to consumers and will serve a smaller caseload of consumers.

Full-Time Minimum Requirement: Bachelor's degree.

Part-Time Minimum Requirement (20 hours per week): Only for candidates with a high school diploma AND currently enrolled in a Bachelor's degree program with a graduation date within 6 months of a verbal job offer.

Service Coordinator (Full-Time)

Starting Rate: \$22.8155 per hour

Minimum Requirement: Master's degree.

In lieu of a Master's degree, a Bachelor's degree with at least 1 year of experience in developmental disabilities or a related field.



Consumer Support Technician III (Full-Time)

Starting Rate: \$17.1735 per hour

Minimum Requirement: High School diploma and at least 1 year of office clerical work experience.
